DGR MONTHLY MEMBERSHIP REPORT**

Riverside County Democratic Party

1. Monthly Meeting was held on August 8, 2022 via Zoom
 - a. Business was minimal
 - i. RCDP Chair, Tisa Rodriguez, reported that the next CADEM e-board meeting will be held in November, likely in person in Sacramento
 - ii. The RCDP has another upcoming fundraiser
 1. Party Animals; September 10, 2022; 6:30 pm via Zoom; See attachment
 - b. The remainder of the meeting was an opportunity to hear from various area Democrats who are seeking election in local non-partisan races in the November 8, 2022 Election.

ENDORSEMENT COORDINATOR

1. The Filing Period ended August 12th for races that did not go into extension and on August 17th for those that did go into extension.
2. Work continues to identify which candidates in the local non-partisan races in the November 8, 2022 election are Democrats
 - a. Following research, candidates' names, party of registration, and contact information are entered into the database which is submitted primarily to the RCDP AD Caucus Chairs & Secretaries for their AD Endorsement Work.

RCDP AD 58 Caucus

1. Work continues to determine which candidates in the various governing bodies in Assembly District 58 include candidates who seek the RCDP endorsement.
 - a. Next steps include
 - i. Reaching out to see if any of the candidates (who have been registered as Democrats within 90 days of the vote for endorsement) wish to receive the RCDP endorsement;
 - ii. Sending to those interested candidates the RCDP Questionnaire to be completed by the candidates;
 - iii. Interviews by members of the RCDP AD 58 Caucus;
 - iv. Voting by the RCDP AD 58 Caucus members re: endorsement recommendations
 - v. Voting upon recommendations by the RCDP AD 58 Caucus by the RCDP Membership to affirm or not the RCDP AD 58 Caucus' Recommendations.
